John Herman Groh, 64, of Chester, MD died on December 6, 2012 at the Johns Hopkins Bayview Medical Center.

Born on March 3, 1948, he was the son of the late John and Camille Groh. In 1971, he married the former Nancy Elizabeth Sherman. Mr. Groh joined the Annapolis Police Department on March 15, 1973, where he worked for 25 years. After his retirement, he stayed with the Annapolis Police as a civilian employee until 2010.
