John Heller Haley of Royal Oak, died Tuesday, January 28, 2014, at Memorial Hospital in Easton. He was 76. Mr. Haley was born November 25, 1937 in Baltimore, MD, to the late Edward and Margaret Heller Haley.

He graduated from Calvert Hall College High School in 1957. On April 12, 1959, he married Jane Bechtel in Falls Church, VA. They lived in Parkville, MD, until December 1983, when they moved to Royal Oak, MD, and resided there for over 20 years. Mr. Haley worked at Black and Decker for 38 years and retired as a manager in the Engineering Test Department.

Mr. Haley was a member of Sts. Peter and Paul Mission Chapel in St. Michaels. He was also a member of Royal Acres Community Association and Edge Creek Boat Club. He served for many years in the Maryland Air National Guard, 175th Squadron.
