John "Jack" J. Peddicord, Jr. died peacefully at home with his wife Phyllis by his side on September 22, 2023. He was 80 years old.

Born in Baltimore on October 2, 1942, he was the son of the late John J. Peddicord, Sr. and Mary Madeleine Beavan.

After graduating from Mount Saint Joseph's in Baltimore, Jack enlisted in the US Air Force, and was stationed in Japan in the Vietnam War.

Upon his honorable discharge in 1965, Jack went on to work as a machinist, eventually landing at Northrop Grumman and working there until his retirement.

Jack had a love of the water which he enjoyed after moving to the Eastern Shore as an adult with his first wife, Rita Yaffe (d.) and raised their children Tina and JJ. Jack was a kind man of deep faith who was always willing to help anyone in need. He proudly served with the Knights of Columbus- one of his great joys in this role was visiting the veterans at Perry Point. He loved to garden, work in his yard, and take trips with his wife Phyllis whom he married in August 2001. He was a dog lover, and his dog "Ace" was a faithful companion until the end.

Jack is survived by his loving wife, Phyllis, along with son John J "JJ"

Jack was preceded in death by his daughter Tina, brother Edward Peddicord, sisters Helen Peddicord and Marie Wilson, and his parents.
