



## John J. Jubin

March 7, 1933 - December 1, 2017

John Jacob Jubin of Queenstown, MD, died on December 1, 2017, at the Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 84 years old.

Born in Newark, NJ, on March 7, 1933, he was the son of the late Rudolf and Josephine Jubin. John, a graduate of Seton Hall University, started his career in New Jersey in Engineering, Purchasing, and Sales related fields. In 1969, he eventually opened his own company, Tri J Corporation, which was a representative sales company for the Semiconductor & Chemical industries. His success with Tri J Corporation led him to found Semtronics, a manufacturer and worldwide distributor for ESD/Static Control products based in Peachtree City, GA, with offices in Oldwick & Watchung, NJ. John retired from Semtronics in 1999, and decided to move to the Eastern Shore of Maryland, falling in love with the scenic beauty, wildlife and waterways. He and his wife Mary made their home in Queenstown on the Wye River. John, always looking for a new challenge, turned his love of sales to real estate and became a Realtor for Long and Foster in Stevensville.

John was happiest working on the farm and driving his tractor. He was an avid equestrian and horse owner, a dog owner and animal lover, enjoyed golfing, fishing, woodworking/cabinet making, and loved spending time in the kitchen cooking and baking, especially during the holidays.

He is survived by his loving wife, Mary Jubin; his sons Bradford Tyler Jubin (Kristy) of Tyrone, GA and Jeffrey Jubin (Wendy) of Jamesburg, NJ; grandchildren, Madison, Christian, Alexandra, Jeffrey Tyler and Caitlin; a sister in-law, Cirila "Lily" Jubin; and many nieces and nephews, Ronnie Jubin of Watchung, NJ, Greg Jubin of Alexandria, VA, Lisa Jubin of Orange Grove, NJ and Kara Jubin in CA. He was preceded in death by his brothers, Frank and Harry Jubin.
