John Wilmer Legg of Church Hill, MD, formerly of Kent Island, died at the Hospice of Queen Anne's Inc., Centreville, MD, on Thursday, July 5, 2012. He was 89.

Born January 23, 1923, in Chester, MD, he was the son of the late, Oliver and Nataline Hunter Legg. He attended Stevensville High School. He married N. Ruth Cox of Baltimore, MD, on June 7, 1947. During his career, Mr. Legg was a dairy farmer and later in his career a grain farmer. After retiring, he caned chairs at his home in Chester.

He was a member of Kent Island United Methodist Church, Chester, MD, where he was active singing in the choir. He was also active in the United Methodist Men's breakfast and other functions at the church.
