John Lombardo of Stevensville, Maryland, formerly of Chestertown, Maryland died Wednesday, September 1, 2004 at the Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 85.

Born July 3, 1919 in Mount Pleasant, Pennsylvania, he was the son of the late Anthony and Frances Leach Lombardo. He graduated from Penns Grove High School in 1939. He served in the US Army, from September 25, 1942 and was honorably discharged on November 15, 1945. During World War II he was involved in the “Battle of the Bulge” and “Remagen Bridge”.

He owned and operated Lombardo’s Sub Shop, a family restaurant in Chestertown for 32 years. He enjoyed writing songs, singing, guitar playing, gardening, and playing baseball. He was a member of the American Legion in Chestertown, the Knights of Columbus, and the Bing Crosby Historical Society. John Lombardo loved people and people loved him. He could entertain everyone with his beautiful, rich voice, as he sang songs in the crooner’s style of Bing Crosby, Perry Como, and Frank Sinatra. He always had the time for genuine conversation and a kind word for everyone he met.

Mr. Lombardo is survived by his wife of 57 years, Prudence Lombardo; one son, Anthony Lombardo of Glassboro, NJ; three daughters, Tanina Godar and her husband, Jim of Crownsville, MD, Gina Jones and her husband, Jeff of

Denver, CO, and Rosanna Burnham and her husband, Jeff of Wilmington, DE, and three grandchildren, Michael T. Godar, Taylor Ann Jones, and Isabella Burnham.
