John Emory MacBride of Warwick, MD died after a 3 ½ year battle with multiple sclerosis on Sunday, July 17, 2005 at his home. He was 56.

Born October 25, 1948 in Havre de Grace, MD, he was the son of the late, Bill MacBride and Alberta Goodrich Milburn.

He owned and operated the NAPA Auto Parts Store in Bel Air for 10 years, and bred and raised thoroughbred racehorses at New Horizon Farm, where he also resided. He retired in January of 2002.
