John Wilmot Mann, Jr., of St. Michaels, MD, died at the Pines on March 12, 2014. He was 92.

Born in Los Angeles, CA, on September 6, 1921, he was the son of the late John Wilmot, Sr., and Alice Kirkpatrick Mann. He was raised in Bethesda, MD, where he graduated from Bethesda Chevy Chase High School in 1939. He then received his Bachelor of Science Degree from the University of Maryland. Mr. Mann served in the U.S. Army Air Corp in Central Africa in the Air Transport Command. Following the release from active duty, he returned to college and received his B.S. and then an Accounting Degree from Benjamin Franklin University of Washington, DC.

While he was in college he was a member of Phi Delta Theta. During his career, he worked for the Office of Naval Intelligence as a special agent and as a Senior Analyst for the U.S. Government in the Small Business Administration. He retired after 30 years of service in January 1979.

Mr. Mann married Mary Elizabeth Rogers of Washington, DC, on December 31, 1946. She pre-deceased him in January 1968. On October 5, 1985, he married Dorothy A. Mann of St. Michaels.

He was a member of Christ Episcopal Church, St. Michaels, the Harbortown

Golf Club in St. Michaels, Easton Elks Lodge and American Legion Post #105 of Bethesda, MD.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Mann is survived by a son, John W. Mann, III (Lori), of Ft. Pierce, FL; two daughters, Barbara Hawley (Mark) of Madison, VA, and Elizabeth Venit (Gregory) of Bethesda, MD; a step daughter, Cheryl A. Musser of Boyds, MD; two stepsons, W. Thomas Adams of Parkton, MD and Donald K. Adams, of Bel Air, MD; a brother, James K. Mann of Wilmington, DE; five grandchildren, Whitney Mann and John W. Mann, IV, both of Ft. Pierce, FL, Michael Hawley of Madison, VA, Amy Venit and Gregory Venit, both of Bethesda, MD; six stepgrandchildren, and one great-granddaughter.
