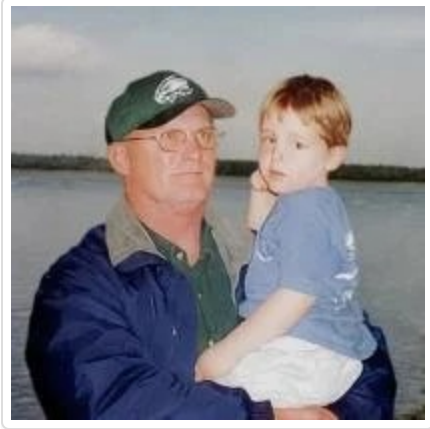




John Edward Mathis Jr.
