John Leo Morgan of Chestertown, MD, died on Saturday, December 12, 2015, at Compass Regional Hospice in Centreville. He was 88.

He was born on April 12, 1927, in Baltimore, MD, the youngest of five sons, of the late Charles Thomas and Anna Hubert Morgan. Mr. Morgan served in the United States Navy at the age of 17. He served in the Atlantic, stationed in Norfolk, and served on the U.S.S. Wisconsin, serving as admiral's chauffer. He returned and married Dorothy Vivian Codd in 1948, his wife of 53 years.

Mr. Morgan worked as a bricklayer with Local Union #1 for his entire career until he retired in 1992. He and his wife then moved to the Eastern Shore and settled in Chestertown. He enjoyed fishing, hunting, and boating. Mr. Morgan was a member of the Vingt-Neuf Bowmen Archery Club.

He is survived by three sons, Robert Earl Morgan of Baltimore, MD, Edward Charles Morgan of Chestertown, MD, and John L. Morgan, Jr. of West Palm Beach, FL; one brother, Mickey Morgan of SC; three grandchildren, Michael, Christine and Erin; and one great-grandson, Brody.
