John Gunther Mosley passed away Friday, December 16, 2011. He was 42 years old.

Born April 26, 1969, to John and Ursula R. Mosley (Schiwy), he was raised in Wye Mills, MD, and graduated from Easton High School in 1987. He worked for Mosley Family Home Repair and later started Return to Splendor, a furniture restoration company.

On May 15, 1993, he married his high school sweetheart Cherie Lynn Mosley (Jones) and had two wonderful children whom he adored. He was a wonderful husband and father. He loved coaching baseball, and you could always find him in the stands supporting Little John playing ice hockey and Emily's softball. He loved his muscle car (Barracuda), fishing, telling jokes, card tricks, writing, bowling, KISS concerts, playing chess, working out in his gym, and spending time with his family. He was a kind and caring person who was always there to give a helping hand. He will be greatly missed by his family and friends.

He is survived by his wife of 18 years, Cherie Lynn Mosley; his daughter Emily Catherine Mosley; and his son, John Harris Mosley. He also is survived by his parents, John and Ursula Mosley of Wye Mills; his sister, Susan Ursula Covington (Kelvin) of VA; two nephews, Chris and Mason Covington; his

maternal grandparents, Gunther and Regina Schiwy of Easton; his in-laws, Cathy and Rick Schaaake of Hillsboro; and many loving aunts, uncles, and cousins.

He was preceded in death by his paternal grandparents, John and Jean Mosley.
