:A Funeral Liturgy for John Munholland of Easton will be celebrated at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, Easton on Monday, October 23, 2000 at 10:00 AM. Mr. Munholland died on Wednesday, October 18, 2000 at the Memorial Hospital, Easton. He was 89.

Mr. Munholland was born in New York City on November 28, 1910. In 1932, he graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy in Annapolis. He served as commanding officer aboard several destroyers, such as the USS Benner, the USS Dunlap, and the USS Meade, and also aboard a destroyer tender, the USS Grand Canyon. He was a recipient of the Bronze Star with Clusters, and the Legion of Merit.

Upon his retirement from the U.S. Navy as a Rear Admiral in 1958, he made his home in Severna Park. He took a job at Westinghouse in Linthicum for eight years. In 1977, he moved to Easton where he was a member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, B.P.O. Elks Lodge #1622, and the Knights of Columbus.

In addition to his wife, the former Jeanne Deming, whom he married in 1939, he is survived by two sons, J. Raymond Munholland of Albuquerque, NM, and Peter H. Munholland of Frederick, MD; four grandchildren and one great-grandchild. A daughter, Tina Marie Smith, a sister, Mary Ellett, and two

brothers, Herbert Munholland and Thomas Munholland are deceased.

Burial will be in Woodlawn Memorial Park, Easton.
