John Parluck of Easton, MD died on March 28, 2006. He was 90 years old.

Born on December 22, 1915 in New York City, of immigrant parents, the late William and Pauline Parluck, he spent most of his youth in New York City. When his parents realized their dream of owning a dairy farm, he spent the balance of his youth in rural Jeffersonville, New York. He graduated from Jeffersonville High School in 1934 and went on to attend Cornell University programs in dairy science.

He spent the balance of his working life managing the family dairy farm in Jeffersonville, and then in High Falls, New York, also caring for his parents until their passing in 1984. He then relocated to Baltimore, Maryland, to live with his late beloved sister, Mary Cornwell and her late husband, Leo Cornwell. He relocated to Easton in 1999.

He enjoyed history, photography, current events, listening to baseball games and enjoying the world of nature.

Mr. Parluck is survived by his nephews, Neil Cornwell, of Baltimore, Maryland and Mitchell Cornwell, of Easton, Maryland; and his nephew Mitchell's wife, Julie, and their two sons, John and Peter.
