John Rossiter of Stevensville, MD, died at Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, MD, on Saturday, April 8, 2000. He was 64.

Mr. Rossiter was born in Fort Worth, TX, on July 1, 1935, the son of the late Francis and Georgia White Rossiter. He attended school in Washington, DC, and was a graduate of Bladensburg High School, Class of 1955. Following Mr. Rossiter's time in the Air Force, he began an apprenticeship with local 602 of Washington, DC, working as a steamfitter. He was injured on the job and went on medical disability prior to retirement in 1984. That year, Mr. Rossiter moved to Stevensville, MD, where he would reside for 16 years,

In 1960–1970, Mr. Rossiter coached football, softball, baseball, and girls basketball for St. Ambrose in Cheverly, MD, where he later became athletic director. He was the assistant coach for Gonzaga College High School football from 1968-1971. From 1972 to 1976, he coached girls basketball at the Academy of Holy Names, where he coached them to a championship season. He was a member of American Legion Post #273 and served on the Bay City Property Owners Association as Vice President and President.

Mr. Rossiter is survived by his fiancé and life companion of 14 years, Rose Johnson of Stevensville, MD; two sons, Michael J. Rossiter of Columbia, MD, and John D. Rossiter of Silver Spring, MD; one daughter, Lisa M. Clark of

Cheverly, MD; one brother, Leo J. Rossiter of Winchester, VA; as well as four grandchildren.

A funeral service will be held at St. Christopher's Catholic Church at 11 a.m. on Tuesday, April 11, 2000. Friends and family may call at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home in Chester, MD, on Monday, April 10, 2000, between the hours of 3 to 5 p.m. and 7 to 9 p.m.
