John Guilford Sherman of Chestertown, MD died on January 5, 2004 at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 77.

Born in Reisterstown, MD on November 28, 1926, he was the son of the late Martin Edward and Mary Agnes Lippy Sherman.

He attended Poly in Baltimore, MD and later enlisted in the U.S. Marine Corps where he served in the Asiatic/Pacific Theatre during WWII where he was wounded, received a Purple Heart Medal, and was honorably discharged in 1945.

Moving back to Baltimore, MD, he worked at Sherman Brothers Ice Company and later with Lincoln Distribution Company a refrigeration and Air Conditioning Company. He then took a position with the U.S. Postal Service as a letter carrier.

In 1974 he married Elsie May Westbrooks. He retired in 1984 and moved to Chestertown, MD.

He enjoyed flying, giving flight instructions, and piloting charter flights. He also enjoyed hunting, gardening, and reading.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a daughter, Linda Faye Johnson of Elkton, MD; two granddaughters, Lena and Jennifer Johnson, both of Elkton, MD and a brother, Martin Sherman of Anchorage, Alaska.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, January 9, 2004 at 11:00 A.M. at Fellows, Helfenbein, and Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., 130 Speer Road, Chestertown, MD where relatives and friends may call on Thursday, January 8, 2004 between the hours of 6:00 and 8:00 P.M. and on Friday, January 9, 2004 one hour prior to the service.
