



## John Wesley Still

July 27, 1938 - November 7, 2020

John Wesley Still, of Easton, MD passed away on November 7, 2020 at the University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. He was 82 years old. Mr. Still was born in Washington, DC to the late Joseph Still and Nellie Hatcher. He graduated from Barber School at Chamberlain Vocational High School in the District. In addition to giving haircuts to his many family members and friends, his lifelong barbering career included military personnel at Fort Belvoir (VA) Army Base. He loved being a barber and always took the time to make sure his family's needs came first. Rarely did a male family member ever need to go to a barbershop for a haircut. He was also proudly employed for over twenty years and retired from the Printing Services Division of the U. S. Senate.

A devout Christian, John and his wife of 59 years, Gloria Grimes Still, and their children were members of Pennsylvania Avenue Baptist Church in Washington, DC, where he was ordained a Deacon. Later, they were members of First Baptist Church of Crofton, MD, where he remained a Deacon, Head Usher and Sunday School Teacher. After they moved to Easton, ten years ago, they attended the First Baptist Church of Easton. John loved dancing with Gloria, was an avid Washington Redskins fan, and loved watching football and making trips to Ocean City, MD.

In addition to his loving wife, Gloria, Mr. Still is survived by sons Martin (Sheila) of Woodstock, GA and Kevin of North Beach, MD; daughters Shelley Still of St. Michael's, MD, Linda Valeda (Gil) of Stevensville, MD, Sarah Kutz

(Sam) of Chesapeake Beach, MD and Carolyn Still of Easton, MD; sister Judy Henderson of Washington, DC; thirteen grandchildren; eleven great-grandchildren (and one on the way) and many nieces, nephews and friends. 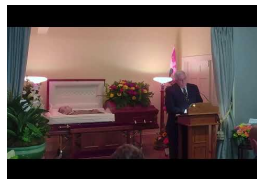

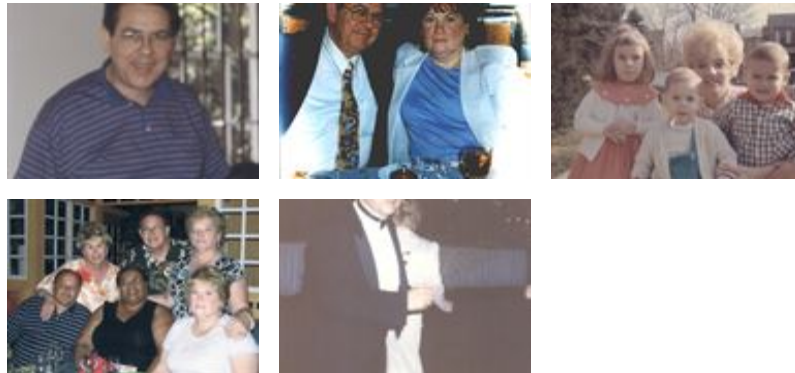

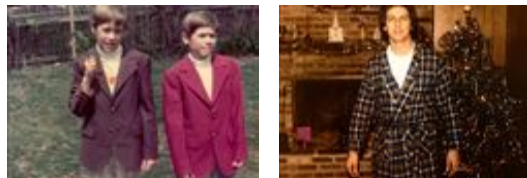
