November 13, 1975 - July 27, 2021

John Temple Terry, better known as “JT”, of Chester, passed away suddenly on July 27th, 2021, at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Laurel. He was 45 years old.

The supreme being of the universe constantly sends through birth Ambassadors to act on his behalf to spread love, comfort, and joy to enhance the lives of others. One of the tasks of the Ambassador is to perform on a level playing field yet be stern when the occasion requires a firm stance. Such an Ambassador was born to the union of Dr. Raymond T. John was adventurous and lived on a fourfold program of life; physical, intellectual, social, and based on a strong spiritual foundation in order to enhance the quality of life for his immediate family and his extended family.

John is survived by his loving wife Lindsay Terry, and four beautiful children: eldest Son Anthony Terry, Daughter(s) Jordyn and Justice Terry, and Legal Guardian and Uncle to Mark Terry. He leaves behind a devoted and adoring Father; Dr. Raymond T. Terry, Sr., eldest Brother Dr. Philip B. Terry-Smith (Dr. Justin B. Terry-Smith), Sister Joinette S. Smallwood, Brother Raymond T. Terry, Jr., and Brother Mark E.T Terry; in addition to a number of Aunts, Uncles, Nieces, Nephews, Cousins, God-Children, and an overabundance of close family-friends and "adopted children", to which he's played a substantial role in raising. He is predeceased by his beloved mother, Rosemary B. Jones-Terry.

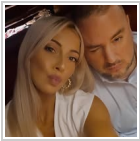

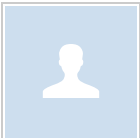
