John Arthur Van Dyke, of Easton, MD, passed away on January 14, 2016. He was born in Wallington, NJ, on September 27, 1930, the son of John and Rose Van Dyke. He is survived by his wife of almost 65 years, Joan L. (Calhoun) Van Dyke whom he married on July 14, 1951; daughters, Jacqueline Horn (David) and Jeryl Van Dyke-Soutiere; brother, Leonard Van Dyk (Maureen); three grandchildren Jacob Hemming, Jonathan (Emelie) Van Dyke, and Jenna Van Dyke; and great-grandson Dylan Hemming.
