John Joseph Walsh Jr. “Jack”, age 83, passed away Tuesday, August 13th, 2024, in his home in Centreville, MD. 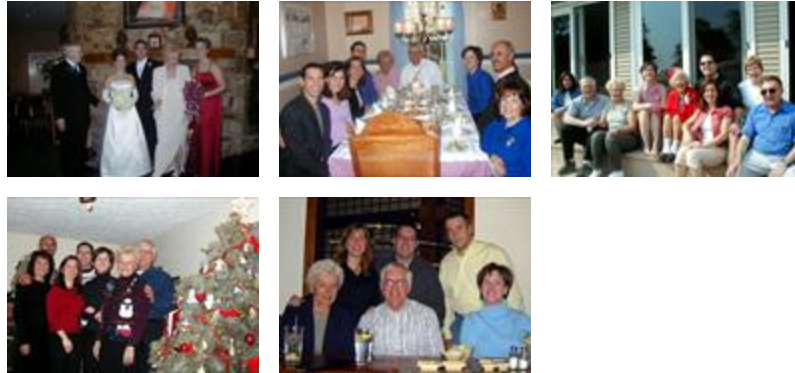
