John Frederick Walters of Chestertown, MD, died on Thursday, December 13, 2012, at Chester River Hospital Center. He was 89.

Mr. Walters was born on May 29, 1923, in Hancock, MD. He was the son of the late James T. and Clara May Starlipper Walters. Mr. Walters enlisted in the United States Army and served in Germany and France and later served stateside with the United State Marine Corps Reserves. He was honorably discharged.

He served with the Prince George County Police Department and later started a landscaping business. He contracted through the telephone company on both the Western and Eastern Shore. He and his wife, Olive Patricia Barr, moved to Church Hill in 1975. Mr. Walters retired in 1990. On November 20, 2000, he was predeceased by his wife.

Mr. Walters was a member of the Marine Corps League. He enjoyed gardening, golfing, his dogs, and he loved to tell jokes. Most of all, he loved his family, especially his grandchildren.

He was predeceased by two sisters, Mary Elizabeth Walters and Dorothy DeVore.
