



## John "Wes" Wesley Sharp

March 13, 1923 - October 30, 2014

John Wesley Sharp, formerly of Easton, MD, died peacefully on Thursday, October 30, 2014, at Homestead Manor in Denton. He was 91.

Wes served in the U.S. Army in World War II and was decorated with two purple hearts during his service.
