John "Jack" Wiley died on October 13, 2013, at William Hill Manor. He was 89.

Born July 23, 1924, in Wilmington, DE, he was the son of the late, Paul and Muriel Eliason Wiley. John was a graduate of Stanford Prep School in Hockessin, DE, and attended the University of Delaware. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II, where he was wounded two times in combat at the Battle of the Bulge. He received the Purple Heart. He returned to Delaware after the war and began a career in farming in Bear, DE. He retired in 1984 and moved to Talbot County on the Miles River.

He enjoyed hunting, fishing, playing golf, and traveling, especially to Ireland. He was a member of the Miles River Yacht Club, Edge Creek Boat Club, The Navy League, and The Masonic Jackson Lodge No. 19, Delaware City, DE.

John "Jack" Wiley was a kind and gentle man, and sincere friend. He will be missed by those whose lives he touched.

Along with his parents he was preceded in death by his wife of 58 years, Christine Mayton Wiley.
