John A. Stranahan of Easton, MD died on Wednesday, August 3, 2005 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton. He was 55.

Born in Greensboro, MD on December 30, 1949, he was the son of Mabel Tribbitt Stranahan of Denton and the late Andrew T. Stranahan. After graduating from Easton High School in 1967, he enlisted in the U.S. Navy where he served as a radioman on the submarine U.S.S. Permit in the Pacific Ocean. Following his release from active duty, he returned to Easton. He began a career as a computer operator, with Delmarva Data Processing Center, of Easton, a position he held for more than 24 years, until retiring in May of this year for health reasons.

John was a member of the E.E. Streets Memorial Post 5118 V.F.W. of Easton.

In addition to his mother, Mr. Stranahan is survived by his wife, the former Kathryn A. Keller, whom he married on September 11, 1981; two sons, John David Stranahan and Steven Lee Stranahan, both of Easton; one brother, Donald R. Stranahan of Queenstown; and two sisters, Connie Cole of Easton and Sandra Hamilton of Denton.
