John Alexander Mollick of Easton died at his home on Tuesday, July 24, 2001 after a heroic battle with cancer. He was 55.

Born in Cohoes, NY on March 16, 1946, he was the son of the late John and Carolyn McDowell Mollick. He graduated from Queensbury High School in New York, and served in the U.S. Navy as a fireman from 1965 until his honorable discharge in 1969. He made his home in Centreville, where he worked as a welder for Agway for twelve years before moving to Easton. For the last seventeen years, and up until the time of his death, he was employed by Maryland Truck Parts as a drive shaft technician.

Mr. Mollick was a member of the American Legion Post 18 in Centreville. He enjoyed fishing, hunting, bowling, and golfing as a member of the Hog Neck Golf Association.

In addition to his wife, the former Brenda Lee Henckel, whom he married in 1979, he is survived by a son, Jonathan William Mollick of Easton; a daughter, Paige Lee of Hamilton, NY; and a sister, Linda Ramsack of Davie, FL. John will always be among our mind, heart, and soul.
