John Allen Standage, 81, of Annapolis, Maryland, passed away at Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, MD, on Monday, March 16, 2009. John was born in Blue Township, KS on July 6, 1927 and is the son of the late Robert Andrew Standage and Eulah Irene (Blasing) Standage.

Mr. Standage grew up in Loveland, CO and moved to Newport Beach, CA at the age of 15. Upon his graduation from Newport Harbor High School in 1945, he entered the US Navy, where he served in the Pacific until the war ended. Returning to Newport Beach, he met the love of his life, Lois Rairdan Small, whom he married in 1951. He was employed by the Public Works Department of the City of Newport Beach, as an electrician and supervisor, for 43 years.
