John C. Riggs of Church Hill, Maryland died after a short illness at his home in the presence of his family on Thursday, February 08, 2007. He was 62.

Born July 25, 1944 in Indianapolis, Indiana, he was the son of the late William V. Riggs, Jr. and Florence W. Riggs. After graduating from Centreville High School in the Class of 1962, he joined the Maryland National Guard for six years.
