John Carroll “Jake” Clough of Church Hill, Maryland died on November 13, 2004 at Corsica Hills Nursing Home in Centreville, Maryland. He was 86.

Born in Queen Anne’s County on January 11, 1918, he was the son of the late E. Scott and Elizabeth Leager Clough. Mr. Clough was a 1935 graduate of Church Hill High School. He served in the U.S. Army during World War II and was honorably discharged in 1946. He started his career as a truck driver driving nationally for 41 years and locally in Kent, Queen Anne’s, and other counties on the Eastern Shore for 11 years. He retired at the age of 80.

He loved horse racing and was a sports enthusiast. He was a member of Jefferson Davis American Legion in Centreville, MD.

Mr. Clough is survived by a son, Franklin C. Clough of Crumpton, Maryland; a brother, Robert Granville Clough of Harrington, Delaware; two grandchildren, Jonathan Carroll Quillen Clough of Church Hill, Maryland and Victoria Louise Clough of Crumpton, Maryland and several nieces and nephews.
