John "Jack" Charles Pape of Stevensville died on December 5, 2001 at Anne Arundel Medical Center, Annapolis. He was 69.

Born in Baltimore County on November 14, 1932, he was the son of the late Horace W. and Marie Trenner Pape. He graduated from Catonsville High School in the class of 1949 and then joined the U.S. Navy and served in the Mediterranean and in Korea. In order to get more flight experience, he transferred to the U.S. Air Force in 1954, and served until 1958. He received his Commercial Flight Engineer's license in 1959 and worked for commercial airlines on World Wide Charters. On March 1, 2000, he retired and moved to Stevensville. He had just recently joined the Kent Island American Legion Post #278.

In addition to his wife, Wanda M. Pape, whom he married on September 10, 1960, he is survived by a son, Eric John Pape of Dayton, Ohio; a daughter, Elita Williams of Dayton, Ohio; and two grandsons, Brent and Derek Williams, both of Dayton, Ohio. His step-mother Sophy Bauch Pape predeceased him.
