John Elliott “Johnny” George of Sudlersville, Maryland died on July 30, 2007 at his home. He was 68.

Born in Sudlersville, Maryland on October 23, 1938 the son of the late John Elliott George, Sr. who predeceased him in 2000 and Lucy Cruikshank George of Sudlersville, Maryland.

Mr. George graduated from Sudlersville High School Class of 1956 and Goldey Beacom College in 1959. He married Penny Krams in 1958.
