A Funeral Liturgy for John Emmett McCullough, Sr. of Easton, MD will be celebrated at the St. Michaels Chapel in St. Michaels, MD on Monday, September 15, 2003 at 11:00 AM.

Mr. McCullough, 72, who was founder of Arlington, Virginia based J.E.M. Research, Inc., a supplier of raw material to manufacturers of diagnostic and therapeutic medical products worldwide and managed by his sons Paul and Christopher, passed away suddenly on Wednesday, September 10, 2003 at Saratoga Hospital, Saratoga Springs, New York. At the time of his death, Mr. McCullough was traveling with his wife, Maureen K. McCullough, looking forward to visiting the new love of his life, his first grandchild, Katherine Kelly (Kate) McCullough, who was born September 11, 2002.

Born April 1, 1931 in Brooklyn, New York, he was the son of the late John and Christine Ambrose McCullough. As a young man and under difficult circumstances, he helped support his widowed mother, Christine McCullough, who became a widow when Mr. McCullough was ten years old. He attended Brooklyn Preparatory School during which time he reached the semi finals of the New York City Golden Gloves Boxing Tournament.

He served in the U.S. Army during the Korean War where he was wounded during combat operations. Following the war, Mr. McCullough received his

B.A. and attended law school at St. John's University in New York.

He was a devout Catholic, a member of Opus Dei, extremely active in every Catholic parish located where he resided and particularly enjoyed teaching C.C.D. classes to parish youth.

He loved reading, boating, golf, and his participation in Republican Party activities which often included his wife, with whom he spent most of his time and was the true love of his life.

Mr. McCullough is survived by his beloved and devoted wife, Maureen, his sons, John, Jr., Paul, Christopher, and Mark, who credit him for all of their success in life, by his loving sister, Sr. Miriam Christine and grandchild Kate.
