John "Johnny" Edward Seward of Goldsboro, MD died at the Caroline County Hospice House, Denton, MD on Wednesday, June 17, 2009. He was 83.

Born October 4, 1926 in Grasonville, MD, he was the son of the late, John Franklin and Florence Rebecca Clevenger Seward. He attended school in Grasonville, MD. During World War II he served in the U.S. Army as a Medic. Following his release from active duty he returned to Grasonville where he made a home and cared for his Mother for many years. Mrs. Seward died in May 2004.
