John Fountain Davidson, Sr. of Stevensville, MD died at Memorial Hospital in Easton on August 27, 2004. He was 79.

Born on Steven's Adventure Farm in Stevensville, MD on September 29, 1924, he was the son of the late Philip T. Davidson and Pauline Jackson Davidson. He attended Stevensville High School. Mr. Davidson worked as a farmer, waterman, hunting guide and in the construction business. His career with Potts Callahan of Baltimore spanned 35 years, until retiring in 1992 as Vice President. Mr. Davidson married Clara Bryan of Stevensville, MD on November 25, 1942.

He was a very avid hunter and fisherman. The Kent Island Businessmen's Association cited him for bravery for his assistance in rescuing two men from a hunting blind, in 1957, off Kent Point. He also held the record for the largest Blue Fish ever caught in the Chesapeake Bay, which was over 22 lbs. In addition he will be remembered by his children, grandchildren, great grandchildren, and many friends for teaching them how to fish, hunt and have respect for the great outdoors.

Mr. Davidson was a member of the Christ Episcopal Church, where he served on the vestry for 2 terms. In addition he was active on the Kent Island Heritage Society and served on the Stevensville Advisory Board.

In addition to his wife, Clara Bryan Davidson, he is survived by six children, Joann D. Anderson of Chester, MD, Rebecca D. Wieland of Easton, MD, Margaret D. Jarboe of Stevensville, MD, John F.
