John Hendrik Kila died Tuesday, January 13, 2009 at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 81.

Born on April 19, 1927, he was the son of John Hendrik Kila and Petronella Boonekamp in Rotterdam, Netherlands. He attended school in Rotterdam, Holland where he received his degree in mechanical engineering. He later received his PhD in psychology from McMasters University in Ontario, Canada. On May 8, 1951 he married Johanna Foncke of Schiedam the Netherlands. Mr. Kila worked in pulp and paper mills. He was known for his knowledge of rebuilding pulp and paper mills in different parts of the world. In 1988, he retired and moved to Stevensville, MD.

He was a former member of the Knights of Columbus and St. Christopher's Catholic Church. In addition he was also a former member of many professional engineer associations. He was a staunch republican and a member of the National Rifle Association.

Mr. Kila is survived by his wife, Johanna Foncke Kila of Stevensville, MD; son, Edward Kila and his wife Cindy of Severna Park, MD; 2 additional daughter-in-laws, Jennifer Kila of Coconut Grove, FL and Teresa Finn of Arlington, TX; 4 grandchildren, Richelle Kila of Arlington, TX, Kathleen Kila of Severna Park, MD, Amanda Kila of Severna Park, MD, and Danielle Kila of Severna Park,

MD. He was preceded in death by his sons, Jeffrey and Richard Kila and sister, Petronella Hoppers.
