John H. Newcomer of Bozman, MD passed away on Wednesday May 31, 2006 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 90.

Born May 15, 1916 in Smithsburg, MD, he was the son of the late Keller J. and Cora Brown Newcomer. After graduating from Smithsburg High School in 1934, he attended Parks Air College in St. Louis, Missouri. He became a pilot while serving in the Naval Reserves. In 1951 he took a position with the Flying Tiger Line, now known as Fed-Ex, where he remained until his retirement in 1976. He resided in Florham Park, NJ until moving to Bozman, MD in 1978.

He was a member of the Presbyterian Church of Easton.

His wife, the former Frances Phelps, whom he married November 26, 1944, died March 5, 1991.

Mr. Newcomer is survived by two daughters, Barbara Pape and her husband Roger, and Joanne Brown and her husband Blaine; a brother, Richard Newcomer; two grandchildren, Carrie Brown and Amanda Brown; and his loving partner, Lorna Shinn. He was predeceased by a brother, Robert Newcomer.
