John J. Anderson III of Stevensville died on Friday, March 1, 2002 at Anne Arundel Medical Center. He was 81.

Born on June 10, 1920 in Baltimore, He attended Baltimore Poly Tech. Institute. He worked for the National Can Corporation from 1937 – 1941 as a Machinist. He then served in the U.S. Navy (Seabee division) during W.W.II in the Philippines. After being honorably discharged in 1945, he returned to the National Can Corporation. On November 22, 1947, he married the former Evelyn L. Griffith. He went to work for The Black & Decker Manufacturing Company in 1949 as a manufacturing engineer. During this time, Mr. Anderson was the business agent for The Mello Men, a teenage big band. He retired in 1981. He moved to Kent Island in 1984.

Mr. Anderson was a member of Galilee Lutheran Church, American Legion Post # 278, and the V.F.W. He was associated with the Boys Scouts of America for 51 years; during the time he started scout troop #653 and took over troop #652.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a daughter, Jacquelyn “Jackie” M. Anderson of Stevensville; a son, Edward L. Anderson of Baltimore; two sisters, Helen Gibbs of Florida and Margaret Evosevich of White Hall, MD; a brother, Richard Anderson of Forest Hill; a brother in law, Harry L. Griffith of

Stevensville, MD; 2 grandchildren, John W. Anderson and Jennifer M. Anderson; numerous nieces and nephews, step grandchildren, and step great grandchildren. Mr. Anderson was predeceased by one brother, Edward W. Anderson.
