



Johnnelle R. Culhane

December 17, 1942 - May 23, 2010

Easton, MD – Johnnelle R. Culhane died at Talbot Hospice House on May 23, 2010. She was 67 years old.

Born in Long Prairie, MN on December 17, 1942, she was the 5th of 6 daughters of Carl and Rosemonde Lampart. On October 21, 1961, she married the late William Roy Culhane. She earned certification as a Medication Technician and as a Nursing Assistant from the Maryland Board of Nursing, and worked as a Nurse Technician, most recently at Chapel District Elementary School, until her failing health forced her to retire. She had lived and made friends in many places, including Colorado Springs, CO, and Stevensville, MD.

She is survived by her sons: William R. Culhane, II, of Austin, TX, Craig C. Culhane, and his fiancée, Kim, of Easton, and Matthew R. Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Easton, MD, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

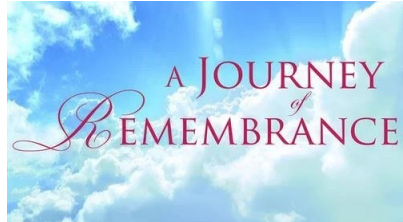
