John Philip Gutting of Church Hill, Maryland died on December 31, 2006 at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, Maryland. He was 63.

He was born on May 1, 1943 in Shelbyville, Indiana, the son of the late, Captain J. Philip Gutting and Betty Morris Gutting of Chestertown, Maryland. He was a 1961 graduate of Annapolis High School and in 1969 he earned a Bachelor of Landscape Architecture with Honors from the University of Illinois. He married Suzanne Flaer in 1966 and in 1970 they moved to Annapolis, Maryland. John's design practice was established in Annapolis in 1970. Among his accomplishments are: St. John's College (Annapolis) 100 year design plan, Outdoor Pavilion and Landscape Design for Chester River Hospital Center, Kent County Courthouse Landscape Design in Chestertown, MD, brick walk restoration and distinctive design for High Street for the town of Chestertown, Terrapin Nature Park in Stevensville, MD, Peninsula Park in Arnold, MD, and many private residential properties from Georgetown, MD to Estates on the Eastern Shore.

Mr. Gutting's professional awards include the heritage Award for Architecture and Design Magazine, Progressive Architecture Honor Award for Urban Design, Baltimore Magazine, The Baltimore Sun Magazine, Chesapeake Life, and Nova Scotia Nature Trust Legacy Circle.

Mr. Gutting enjoyed photography, fishing, running, cycling, basketball, and
