John Patrick Hill of Denton, MD died on Sunday, April 27, 2008. He was 39.

Born June 12, 1968 in Washington, D.C., he was the son of John Alvin and Patricia Hoffman Hill of Annapolis, MD. A 1986 graduate of Annapolis High School, he had worked as a caregiver at the Benedictine School, as an assistant manager for Holiday Inn and at the time of his death was a school bus driver for Queen Anne's County Public Schools.

In his spare time, he enjoyed fishing, crabbing, boating, and bowling.

In addition to his parents, Mr. Hill is survived by his wife, the former, Amanda Jane Stone, whom he married March 3, 1993; six children, Thomas Albert James, Lily Patricia Margaret, Georgianna Louise, Zoe Amanda, Caroline Elizabeth Rose, and Anna Beth Leigh; one brother, Joseph Albert Hill of Annapolis; and two sisters, Jeanne Anita Christenson of Churchton, MD and Judith Leigh Hill of Staten Island, NY.
