John "Jack" Rudolph Sailer of Queen Anne, MD died at Corsica Hills Nursing Home, Centreville, MD on Tuesday, April 25, 2006. He was 87.

Born September 8, 1918 in Elizabeth, NJ, he was the son of the late Rudolph John and Alice Drake Sailer. He graduated from Union High School, Class of 1935 and then attended Engineering School, Rutgers College in New Brunswick, NJ. During World War II, he served in the U.S. Army in the Pacific Theatre and was Lt. Col when he received his discharge. Following his release from active duty he returned to college and received a degree in Law. On February 2, 1952 he married the former, Katharine Grove of Summit, NJ. During his career he practiced many years for the Elizabethtown Water and Gas Co. in Elizabeth City, NJ. They resided in Summit, NJ for 24 years. In 1980 he retired and moved to Pratt Mansion, Queen Anne, MD.

Mr. Sailer was very active in the Miles River Power Squadron where he taught many courses. He enjoyed skeet and trap shooting and was an expert marksman.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Sailer is survived by a son, J. Hampton Sailer of Eatonton, NJ and a daughter, Katharine "Kit" Sailer of Jersey City, NJ. He was pre-deceased by a brother, Norris Hampton Sailer and a sister, Catherine "Kay" Stillman.

Funeral services will be held at St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Chestertown, MD on Saturday, April 29, 2006 at 11:00 AM.

Burial will be at St. Paul's Episcopal Church Cemetery, Chestertown, MD.
