John Stewart “Stew” Chanaud died at his son’s home on Friday, December 5, 2003. He was 67.

Mr. Chanaud was born in Baltimore, MD to the late Dr. Norman P. and Elizabeth Curtin Chanaud. He graduated from Centreville High School class of 1955 and in 1957 he enlisted in the U.S. Army and was honorably discharged in 1960.
