John T. "Jack" Manning Sr. died on Saturday, March 20, 2004 in the Chester River Hospital Center, Chestertown, MD. He was 84.

Born near Millington, MD, he was the son of the late John T. and Arabelle Travis Manning. He worked for 30 years as a school bus contractor for the Queen Anne's county public school system, and also worked as a custodian for Sudlersville Elementary School and Sudlersville Bank.

He was a Life Member and past Chief of the Sudlersville Volunteer Fire Co. and through many years of service he also served as Assistant Chief and Ambulance Captain for many of those years and lastly served the Department as a Fire Policeman. Mr. Manning loved to drive his car, and was constantly seen throughout his community. He enjoyed country music, especially Loretta Lynn and enjoyed traveling.

son, Buddy Morris of Clayton, DE; a foster son, Herman Reynolds of Centreville, MD; a foster daughter, Mattie Supers of Sudlersville, MD; 13 grandchildren, 21 great grandchildren and 2 great great grandchildren.

He was predeceased by a sister, Ella Pratt; a brother, George Manning; a daughter, Dorothy May Higgs Anderson; a son, John "Jerry" Manning Jr. and a grandson, Robert Higgs.

Funeral services with full fire department honors will be held on Friday, March 26, 2004 at 1pm. in the hall at the Sudlersville Volunteer Fire Department. Friends and family may call at the firehouse after 12 noon.

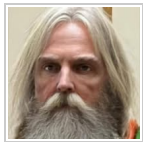
