Trappe: John Theodore "Jack" Berrier, 81, of Trappe, MD, died suddenly Thursday, April 2, 2009 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. Born October 26, 1927 in East Orange, New Jersey, he was the only son of Theodore Berrier and Miriam Book Berrier. He attended Fishburne Military School, Waynesboro, VA and Bullis Prep School, Washington, DC, where he was a three sport athlete. He graduated from the Naval Academy in 1951, where he was a four year letterman in baseball. He received a commission in the Air Force piloting B29's during the Korean War.

Jack, as he was known, joined Chesapeake and Potomac Telephone Company following his military duty and spent his whole career programming computers, retiring in 1989. He loved playing golf at Hog Neck and growing tomatoes in his garden.

He is survived by his sons Bruce and his wife Vicki of Easton, MD, Barney and his wife Amanda of Columbia, SC and Bret of Trappe, MD; grandchildren, Brooke, Logan, Davidson, Margaret and Emma.

He was predeceased by his wife of 53 years, Joy Goodacre Berrier, who died on March 4, 2004, and his sister, Virginia Berrier.

A memorial service will be held on Thursday, April 9, 2009 at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Easton at 7:00 pm where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
