



## John W. Simperts, III

April 5, 1960 - February 20, 2009

John W. Simperts, III of Easton, MD died of congestive heart failure on Friday, February 20, 2009 at his home at the age of 48.

Born in Wilmington, DE on April 5, 1960 he was the son of Rev. Dr. John W. Simperts, Jr. and was pre-deceased by his mother, Ethel Smith Simperts in 1993.

His childhood years in Centreville, MD found him involved in Little League Baseball and Queen Anne's football.

As a teenager, John played in the drum section of the Seaford High School Marching Band, Seaford, DE, followed by his graduation from Queen Anne's County High School, Class of 1978. While a student at Chesapeake College he played baseball and soccer.

He served on the Camp Pecometh staff for fifteen years where his father was the director. John then served as waterfront manager and trips coordinator at Trippe Lake Camp, Poland, Maine for two years.

He was a self employed house painter in Talbot County in his adult years, having survived quintuple bypass heart surgery in 2002.

He was an avid duck hunter and fisherman his entire life.

In addition to his father, John is survived by his sister, Deborah Anne Simpers of Denton, MD and by his brother, David K. and his wife, Elizabeth Ann of Denton and his nephews, Jordan and Jamie who were the joy of his life.

A Memorial service will be held on Saturday, February 28, 2009 at 2:00 PM at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, 100 Peachblossom Road, Easton, MD with Pastor Gary L. Moore officiating.
