John Z. Stoltzfus of Kennedyville, MD, died peacefully at home in his sleep Wednesday, August 11, 2004. He was 75.

Born July 11, 1929 in Honeybrook, PA, he was the son of the late John P. and Annie Zook Stoltzfus. On November 7, 1950, he married Naomi K. Stoltzfus, and they lived in Holy Matrimony for 53 years, 9 months and 4 days.
