Jon Cortland Bupp of Chester, MD, died at his home on July 7, 2014. He was 69.

Mr. Bupp was born in Baltimore, MD, on July 23, 1944, to the late Malcolm Bupp and Catherine (Davis) Bupp. He grew up in Parkville, MD, and met and married the former Lessie Dorse. They moved to the Eastern Shore in 1997.
