Jonathan Carroll Quillen Clough of Millington, MD, died Thursday, October 10, 2013. He was 28.

Jonathan was born October 4, 1985, in Easton, MD, the son of Franklin Carroll Clough and Karol Jean Ford. Jonathan was a 2003 graduate of Queen Anne's County High School. After high school, he went to work for Billy's Crabs and on the weekends he delivered pizza for Pizza Town in Millington. Jon played on both a pool league and a bowling league and loved both. He was an avid Redskins fan and also enjoyed hunting, fishing, going to Crumpton sale, and his animals.

Jon was preceded in death by his paternal grandfather, John Carroll Clough.

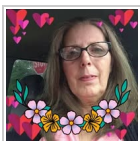

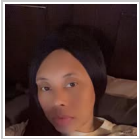

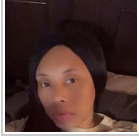
