



## Dr. Jonathan A. Hummel

November 23, 1932 - June 22, 2014

Dr. Jonathan A. Hummel died Sunday, June 22, 2014 at Clare Bridge Assisted Living in Fort Collins, CO. He was 81.

Born in Salem, New Jersey on November 23, 1932, he was the son of the late Ira Lee C. and Margaret Carpenter Acton Hummel. He was a graduate of Haverford College and NYU Medical School. He practiced medicine as a surgeon for more than 40 years. He was an avid horseman and Fieldmaster for Wye River Hounds.
