September 13, 1962 - June 29, 2022

Joseph “Joe” Bodensteiner passed away on June 29, 2022. He was 59 years old.

Joe was born on September 13, 1962, to the late William Bodensteiner and Barbara Bodensteiner.

He met the love of his life, Maureen O’Malley, at Niagara University where they attended undergrad together. Joe went on to study at Albany Law School and then served in the US Army for 6 years in the JAG Corps, eventually retiring from the Army Reserves in 2007. In 1994, he went to work for the Nuclear Regulatory Commission, practicing law for two years and then eventually transitioning into a criminal investigator. After working 10 years for the NRC, he accepted a position at the Treasury Dept. working another 10 years and finally ending his career with 11 years working for the Peace Corps.

Joe enjoyed model cars, trains, puzzles, and learning how things worked. Most of all, Joe loved improving his estate, inside and out, to find new and fun ways to bring his family together.

Along with his father, Joe is predeceased by his mother-in-law, Janice O’Malley.

He is survived by his wife, Maureen Bodensteiner; mother, Barbara

Bodensteiner; son, Brendan Bodensteiner; daughter, Kellie Bodensteiner; and grandchildren, Jackson and Addison Bodensteiner.
