

Joseph Dunstan Hayden

April 17, 1932 - May 15, 2024

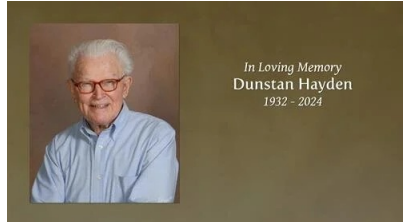
Joseph Dunstan Hayden, age 92, a resident of Heron Point, Chestertown, MD, since 2021, died on May 15, 2024 in Chestertown, MD. Born in 1932 in Washington DC, Dunstan attended Blessed Sacrament Parochial School and St. Anselm's Abbey prior to getting a BA at the University of Chicago. Returning to St. Anselm's Abbey after college, he became a Benedictine monk and was ordained a priest in 1959. He taught math at the Abbey School, Obtained an MA in mathematics and co-wrote three high school math textbooks. He served as the Abbey School's headmaster from 1968 to 1970. He left the Abbey and the active priesthood in 1970. He obtained his PhD in Educational Technology from Catholic University and was a member of the math faculty at Northern Virginia Community College. Involved for decades with the Community of Christ, an ecumenical Christian community in DC, he later joined Westmoreland UCC Church in Bethesda, MD. Upon moving to Heron Point with his second wife, Barbara Slater Hayden, Dunstan became a member of the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown. His passions were ecumenism, theology, sacred and classical music, reading, and writing. He is survived by his wife Barbara Salter Hayden, his brother Martin Hayden of Huston, TX, and wonderful nephews and nieces. A celebration of life service will be held at Heron Point in Wesley Hall, 501 E. Campus Ave. Chestertown, MD, at 11 am Saturday, June 29, 2024.
