



Joseph B. Hayes

April 4, 1933 - March 15, 2017

Joseph Barry Hayes of Queenstown, MD, died at home on March 15, 2017. He was 83.

Born on April 4, 1933, in Brooklyn, NY, he was the youngest of four children of the late John Hayes and Katherine Novella.

After graduating high school in New York, Joe proudly enlisted in the Marine Corps, serving in the Korean War. When he returned, he began working for a small airline that would later evolve into USAir. He retired as the Chief Pilot in Baltimore after a 31-year aviation career. In 1979, Joe and his family moved to Queenstown, MD, where he was a member of St. Christopher's Catholic Church.

Joe is survived by his wife of 55 years, Margie Hayes; son Mike Hayes, his wife Katharina and grandsons Collin and Bennett Hayes (Charlotte, NC); daughter, Sharon Brinster, her husband John, and grandchildren Christina and Joey Brinster; son Steve Hayes, his wife Kelly McGrath, and grandchildren Jack and Audrey Hayes and Tina and TJ Kelliher (Boston, MA); sisters Katherine McArdle and Mary Lu Plunkett (NY); and many nieces and nephews. His brother, Jack Hayes, predeceased him.

A mass will be held at 11:00 AM, on Monday, March 20, 2017, at St.

Christopher's Catholic Church in Chester, MD.
